She led the reorganization of the department committee structure to better reflect the current issues and needs of youth development. She led the scholarship team that funded, planned, conducted, and evaluated an extensive training, complete with supporting curriculum, for county youth/adult teams. This training was the impetus for numerous county youth/adult partnerships and professional presentations. In support of the 4-H program, Rita served on the Governor's Office on Volunteerism Conference Planning Group, provided educational support to various external agencies and organizations. Rita was an active in the Catholic Charities, volunteered at St. Joseph's Church and for the American Heart Association and other charities.
